	Pack in book sack/carry-on
	Change of clothes with extra underwear and socks (in case of delays
	or lost luggage upon arrival)
	Toothbrush, travel sized toothpaste, deodorant, comb/brush, etc. (All
_	liquids must be less than 3 oz. and in a quart sized bag for security checks)
	Electronics such as laptops, cameras, phones (including all chargers
	and be sure all devices are fully charged before traveling.
	Some checkpoints will require you to turn your devices on)
	Personal medications (be sure all prescribed medication is in proper bottles with your name on the bottle)
	Food/snacks
	Passport, drivers license, money (new \$50/\$100 bills), and credit/debit
	cards should be kept in a safe and accessible place while traveling. Make sure
	you notify your bank that you will be traveling if you plan to use your cards.
П	Jacket/sweater or sweatshirt (Kenya can get chilly and so can airplanes)
	Travel pillow, sleep mask, ear plugs etc.

	Journal, bible, notebook, pen
Η	Solar charger/battery packs for charging your electronics (Charging opportunities
	will be provided but battery packs/solar chargers are a wonderful idea to help
_	keep your devices charged)
	Personal clothing: underwear, socks, jeans, t-shirts (no spaghetti straps or
	tank tops). Men can wear shorts. Ladies can wear capris or jeans/pants
	(no yoga pants or leggings allowed). Light jacket. For church: women need a skirt/dress and men need casual pants and
	polo/button down shirt
	Tennis shoes or closed toe shoes for outreach activities (thick soled
	shoes are best due to thorns). Sandals can be worn to church.
	Flip flops/sandals for shower
	Toiletries: shampoo, soap, feminine hygiene supplies, deodorant and lotions
	Personal medications - enough for the duration of your trip
	Sunscreen and insect repellent
B	Flashlight/headlight and extra batteries
H	Optional: portable battery operated fan
H	Personal snacks Reusable water bottle (everyone must bring one)
	Laugable water bettle (everyone must bring one)

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Jewelry: leave all valuable jewelry at home. Men, please remove any piercings upon arrival. No gauges. Tattoos are fine as long as it is not anything inappropriate. Please cover, if so. International adapters for charging
